Commissioner Eaves responded that she had completed her homework by discussing this request with the Managers of O-Charley's, Wes Browne, Rodney Davis, Jason Vaughn who is the manager of Madison Gardens, and Chuck Fields of Paddy Wagon. Mayor Barnes questioned if this took place before or after the First Reading. Commissioner Eaves explained that it took place prior and after the First Reading. Mayor questioned Commissioner Eaves why she didn't share that information with the rest of the commission. Commissioner Eaves responded that she had shared the information with the Commissioners which also voted in favor. Mayor expressed that he was more upset with the process because that information was not disclosed to entire commission at the First Reading. Mayor noted that by extending these hours are really adding liability to these businesses. Mayor stated that the only people at a bar on a later Sunday night are the alcoholics. Commissioner Eaves responded there's 17 weeks' worth of alcoholics because it's NFL football season on Sunday's nights. Mayor stated that he was unaware of these intentions, however asked the Commission to remember that only an Ordinance can amend an Ordinance which now makes Ordinance 17-24 in void and will start over.
