

ORDINANCE NO. 16-11

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, KENTUCKY RE-NAMING A STREET IN THE RICHWOOD SUBDIVISION

WHEREAS, there exist within the Richwood Subdivision located in the City two streets with almost identical names, namely, Amber Hill Drive and Amber Hill Court, and the street numbering systems for the homes on those two streets are identical; and

WHEREAS, the City’s GIS Coordinator has been advised that, as a result of the similar street names and the identical numbering systems, mail to the residents on the two streets often winds up being misdelivered and there exists the further possibility that the issue may in the future create confusion for emergency responders, and the Board of Commissioners finds it to be in the public interest that one of the two streets be re-named; and

WHEREAS, the GIS Coordinator has by letter advised the affected residents and the appropriate agencies of the issue and in those letters advised that it would be his recommendation to the Board of Commissioners that “Amber Hill Court” be re-named “Chatham Court”;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that:

SECTION I

Amber Hill Court, a City street in the Richwood Subdivision, is hereby re-named Chatham Court.

SECTION II

This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its enactment following second reading, and publication in accordance with the requirements of applicable Kentucky law.


